



BASKETBALL CAMP COUNSELOR

Responsibilities:

1. Directly reports to the Camp Director and Assistant Camp Director while assisting both the Camp Director and Assistant Camp Director in the marketing and management process of camp.
2. Role models and increases camper and staff awareness of the “Starting Five” camp core values: R.I.T.E.S = Respect, Integrity, Teamwork, Excellence and Service.
3. Assists Camp Director and Assistant Camp Director in managing the day-to-day operations of the camp including: Conducting the camp daily curriculum, Maintaining great public relations with parents and/or guardians and Ensuring camp stays compliant with camp on-site and off-site duties and responsibilities required by Chase Your Dreams, Inc., and/or NIKE, and/or The Maryland-National Capital Park & Planning Commission.
4. Demonstrates professionalism, courtesy, and honesty to all staff, campers and parents and/or guardians while working for Chase Your Dreams, Inc.
5. Assists Camp Director and Assistant Camp Director in keeping the daily operation of camp organized and on-time by following the itinerary set forth for each day (while having the ability to improvise with the itinerary if necessary).
6. Communicates effectively with staff and campers to ensure the quality of Chase Your Dreams, Inc.
7. Reports all concerns, problems, and issues directly to Camp Director and/or Assistant Camp Director.
8. Helps each camper meet the goals established by the camp for camper development.
9. Ensures all equipment is properly, neatly, and securely stored each day at the completion of camp.

2. Must have high school diploma or equivalent.
3. Must have at least 3 or more years of experience in basketball as a player or coach in AAU, high school, college, or professional ranks.

7. Must have ability to accept supervision and guidance.
8. Must have enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience and self-control.
